It is a school which is meant for uplifting the less privileged children by providing quality education, food, clothing/school uniform, books, stationary, medical attention, nutritional supplements etc. completely free. They highly depend upon charity and donations from various kind-hearted people. But their main focus is to enable the less privileged to empower themselves.

The purpose for the visit was to donate old books and other things collected from St. Mary's School to the Nirwal Sewa so that they can be re-used by those under-privileged children. Students from 'social work club, from class-VI & class-VIII also accompanied social work officer and her trainee to gather knowledge about the working of the institution and experiences of the students of that institute.

This school has a very big campus with a sound infrastructure. Facilities provided there are highly appreciable. They have those facilities which even most of the private schools in Delhi are lacking. Students who were taken to Nirmal Sewa were shocked to see those facilities. They have their library, interactive audio-visual rooms, activity room, computer lab, well-maintained washrooms, science lab, music room, and also meal facilities where benches with tables are fitted nicely.
